

## Friends of the Indian River Area Library Logo Contest Rules

### Eligibility:

The contest is open to individuals in the Indian River area only. The contest is not open to companies, educational institutions, organizations, etc. or to groups associated with such institutions.

### How to Enter:

1. Entries should be emailed to [friends@indianriverlibrary.org](mailto:friends@indianriverlibrary.org)
2. Please use the subject line: IRAL Friends Logo Contest
3. Digital entries:
  - a. Should be in PNG or JPG format in at least 1000 pixels resolution or higher.
  - b. Entries must include the name, age, postal address, phone number, and email address of the entrant.
4. Physical entries can be dropped off at the circulation desk in the Library.
5. The deadline for entries is **November 17, 2022 at 7 p.m.**
6. There is no fee to enter the contest.
7. The Friends of the Indian River Library reserves the right to extend all deadlines associated with this contest to ensure that a significant number of entries are received.

### Submission Guidelines:

1. The logo should work in black and white as well as in color.
2. The only text included should be "Friends of the Indian River Area Library"
3. All entries must not be similar to existing logos or other copyrighted images.
4. The entry should *not* contain photos or any other inappropriate images or symbols.
5. Please limit designs to five colors or less.
6. Submission of an entry constitutes the entrant's full and unconditional agreement to the terms and rules of this contest.

### Judging and Selection of Winner:

1. Submissions will be presented to the judges without identifying entrant information to ensure a fair contest.
2. The winning design will be selected by the Friends of the Indian River Area Library Board. Their decision will be final.
3. The Indian River Area Library reserves the right not to select a winner if, in its sole discretion, no suitable entries are received.
4. The Indian River Area Library reserves the right to disqualify any entrant or entry at its sole discretion.
5. Accepting the prize constitutes permission for the Indian River Area Library to make public and otherwise use the winner's name for publicity purposes.

6. The winner will be required to sign a contract relinquishing all ownership of the logo to the Friends of the Indian River Area Library. In the event that a minor should be selected as a winner, the contract shall be signed by both the minor and custodial parent or guardian.

**Prizes:**

Subject to the requirements outlined above, the winning design will be announced no earlier than December 13<sup>th</sup> at 12 p.m.

The winning designer will receive a \$150 gift card and design recognition.

**Intellectual Property:**

1. All submitted work must be original and not based on any pre-existing design.
2. The designer also certifies that the logo does not infringe upon the rights of any third party and that it does not violate copyright.
  - a. In the event that the winning entry is found to infringe on existing logos or other copyrighted images, the entrant may be held responsible for expenses accrued by the Friends of the Indian River Area Library for the use of the entry.
3. All entries will become sole property of the Friends of the Indian River Area Library and may be displayed publicly, online, in print, for various uses. The winner agrees to transfer all rights, including all intellectual property rights, and title to the entry to the Friends of the Indian River Area Library.

**Acceptance:**

By signing this form, I acknowledge that I have read and agree with the terms and conditions of the Official Rules. I understand that if my entry is selected as the winner, I relinquish all claims to any and all copyrights, royalties, and other benefits derived from the sale of reproduction of the logo other than the prize awarded the winning entry.
